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GPS Liposculpting is so far the latest most revolutionary fat-melting and less invasive body contouring method. Specifically designed to melt away unwanted fat on specific areas of the body, GPS Lipo laser, now available at Dubai Cosmetic Surgery, can achieve results that are mostly unparalleled.

According to Dubai Cosmetic Surgery's AnisaVrabac, compared with the standard laser liposuction, the GPS laser Liposuction is the latest and most advanced laser liposuction procedure for eradication of stubborn fat. "It is also the safest and most precise method of doing away with unwanted fat from the body."

We also caught up with Dr. Bouraoui Kotti to find out more about this new procedure and what's typically involved.

How is GPS lipo different from traditional liposuction and liposculpture procedures?

GPS Liposuction removes the unwanted fat, firms the skin and contours the area under treatment all at the same time. On the other hand, the traditional liposuction just sucks out the unwanted fat and other procedures have to be incorporated to tighten and con-





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tour the area. Again, GPS Lipo has a unique GPS technology that helps the surgeon to accurately locate that area that has the excess and unwanted fat that has to be melted away, while the traditional liposuction and liposculpture do not have, the doctor would just go in 'blindly'. Finally, the GPS technology also regulates the laser system which in turn controls the amount of energy delivered to the excess fatty deposits, and when the energy becomes too much or when the cannula stops moving, it shuts down leaving little to no chance of burns. In addition, the GPS Lipo laser system has a screen which shows real-time visualization of the area to be treated. The tradition liposuction does not have this feature.

How many treatments are usually required?

One session is enough for each area; for instance, if you are targeting the hips, one session is enough. If you are targeting fatty deposits within your belly, that will be another one session and so on. But on the other hand, just like any other procedure, it all depends on the amount of fatty deposits. It is also important to note that GPSLipo, just like the traditional Liposuction, is not for weight loss but for sculpting the body.

What is the price range and how does it compare with traditional liposuction methods?

At Dubai Cosmetic Surgery GPSLipo starts from 15,000 aed, but as usual, the price depends on how big the area to be treated is. The traditional liposuction price starts from 25,000 aed. The main reason for this price difference is because the traditional liposuction is done under general anesthesia in a hospital with a couple of days stay in the hospital hence the overhead costs. With GPSLipo it is done in-office under local anesthesia so there is no need to go to the hospital and the patient goes home immediately after the procedure so fewer fees involved.

What is the typical recovery time?

Basically one can go back to his/her normal regular duties the following day. This is because the procedure is minimally invasive and is performed under local anesthesia in-office, with a decreased surgery time compared to traditional liposuction. The GPSLipo can be used on the face, neck, abdomen, thighs, hips, back, knees, ankles and arms.

On a final note, importantly GPSLipo, is also approved by the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA).
